Woodhall Wheelers Spring Newsletter

Welcome to the first new style Woodhall Wheelers newsletter. The cycling season is well and truly with us, and already four members have completed the 100 mile Louth sportive - the event was reportedly very well organised and not as hilly as it looked on the route plan. Perhaps we will get a few more riders out if it is repeated next year.

Planned Events

16 April - we will be remembering Brian Garrill, one of the founders of Woodhall Wheelers. This year the memorial ride will pause on the Hainton road in memory but then proceed to Wickenby Airfield Café before returning to Woodhall Spa.

22 April - the Lincoln Audax: Reepham - Hagworthingham - Ludford - Reepham. The ride is organised by the Lincoln CTC and last year attracted about 100 riders. The coffee stop in Hagworthingham is particularly good value for money.

23 June - proposed Woodhall Wheelers night ride. The ride will leave Woodhall around 9.15 pm so that we can enjoy the sunset whilst cycling along the River Witham path towards Lincoln. The route passes through Lincoln and over the River Trent to Newark for a coffee stop - probably MacDonalds! Refreshed and onwards towards Sleaford for a 2nd stop before arriving back in Woodhall around dawn. The route will be about 90 miles and largely flat; the pace will be easy. Please let me know if you will be riding - there will be a pre-meet to discuss lights and night riding.

29 June - Castle to Coast to Castle 2017. A very popular 100 mile ride but you need to sign up as places are strictly limited.
